

Students have the choice of 2 course sequences in Social Studies:

Social Studies 30-1, the final course in the 10-1, 20-1 and 30-1 series, explores perspectives on ideologies in eight sequential units. This course has two supervised ADLC exams. A two-part Provincial Diploma Exam must also be written.

All registered students will obtain online access to the course which includes instructional content, multimedia, assignments, discussion forums, quizzes and self-assessments delivered electronically through ADLC's secure website and e-mail.
