

English Language Arts 30-1 is the final course in the academic series that normally leads to university programs. Students study short stories, non-fiction, poetry, a Shakespearean play, a drama, and a novel. Students should have access to a dictionary, a thesaurus, and a writer's handbook. This course has a final exam and a two-part Diploma Exam.

Five credits

Prerequisite: ELA2105 - English 20-1 (50% required) or ELA2104 - English 30-2 (50% required)

English Language Arts 30-2 is the final course in the general series normally leading to college diploma programs. Students focus on basic communication skills while studying literature, including short stories, non-fiction, poetry, modern play, film, and a novel. Students should have access to a dictionary, thesaurus, and writer's handbook. This course has a final exam and a two-part Diploma Exam.

Five credits

Prerequisite: ELA2104 - English 20-2 (50% required) or ELA2105 - English 30-1 (40% required)
